Recruitment of Foreign Health and Physical Education Teacher

Faculty of Education, Prince of Songkla University intends to recruit an individual for the position of foreign health and physical education teacher (1 position), affiliated with Prince of Songkla University Primary Demonstration School, as detailed below.

1. Position being recruited

1 position of health and physical education teacher (foreign staff): Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or higher as specified in the attached document.

2. General qualifications of the applicant

2.1 Having general qualifications and having never had any prohibited characteristics, according to Prince of Songkla University Human Resource Management Regulation, 2016 as specified below.

a) General qualifications:

- 1) Foreign nationality
- 2) Age at least eighteen years old
- 3) Being legitimate to live in Thailand

b) Prohibited Characteristics:

- 1) Being a political official
- 2) Being insane, mentally deranged, quasi-incompetent, or suffering from a serious disease that can affect working
- 3) Being currently suspended from work or having previously been ordered to leave work
- 4) Lacking good morals
- 5) Being an executive committee member or an official in a political party
- 6) Being under bankruptcy
- 7) Having ever been imprisoned, except the imprisonment which was caused by carelessness or for petty offenses
- 8) Having ever been punished by dismissal, discharge, or expulsion from government services, public enterprises, or other state agencies
- 9) Having ever been punished by dismissal, discharge, or expulsion for violating the university rules or other legal regulations
- 10) Having ever been found guilty of cheating in the admission process for civil service recruitment or employment in government agencies

8. Selection process

8.1 Once the application has been received, the recruitment and selection committee will consider the applicant's profile, educational background, personal information, work experience, cover letter, and other documents submitted by the applicant. 8.2 The applicants will be assessed through a written examination, a teaching demonstration, and an interview. The minimum requirement for each method of selection is 70 percent.

9.1 One photo with a straight face, not wearing a hat or dark glasses, and not wearing a face covering, taken within the last 6 months, uploaded as a profile picture.

9.2 One copy of a degree certificate or a certificate of graduation (highest qualification), signed and certified.
